If gum disease is detected, that is treated. If infection inside the tooth is detected, root canal therapy would be recommended as an alternative to extraction. The prevailing belief behind restorative dentistry is a simple one: you can keep all your teeth for all your life.

Cosmetic dentistry is becoming more popular among the general population as new materials and procedures become available. Gaps, chips, discolored and misaligned teeth can be modified to create a beautiful smile accessible to everyone.
